North Carolina Department of Administration Environmental Justice Goals

- 1. Inform marginalized communities about EJ issues and encourage the adoption of EJ practices and initiatives on a quarterly basis.
 - a. Use materials provided by, or developed in conjunction with, DEQ or the EJ Advisory Council that summarizes EJ issues.
 - b. Use the HUB and CIA databases to distribute the one-pager.
 - c. The one-pager can also be in a digital form that points to more comprehensive resources. This could be pushed out through our social media channels.
- 2. Further Enhance Community Engagement and Decision-Making.
 - Ensure meaningful participation of marginalized communities in environmental decision-making through established boards and commissions.
- 3. Make the Department of Administration's public-facing websites more digitally inclusive.
 - a. Actions: Review and revise seven (7) sections of the Department's website that provide information for the public so that they are accessible to citizens with visual impairments and I/DD challenges. The following sections of the Department's website will be reviewed and revised:
 - State Surplus Property
 - Purchase & Contract
 - Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUB)
 - Non-Public Education
 - Indian Affairs
 - Council for Women & Youth Involvement
 - Federal Surplus Property
 - b. Maintain oversight of the existing Language Access tool on the DOA website, accessible by a "Select Language" button in the uppermost right hand corner of the website.
